Ancient Future will perform August 9th at Luther Burbank Center. Ancient Future was formed in 1978 with the goal of bringing world music to a wider audience. Their record "Natural Rhythms" received N.A.I.R.D. Indie Awards in the fields of World Music and Album Cover Design. Dreamchaser debuted at #2 on the JAZZIZ National Airplay Chart and received a 10 out of 10 rating in CD REVIEW. They have recorded with such luminaries as Zakir Hussain, the master of the North Indian tabla, and Alex De Grassi and Darol Anger of Windham Hill fame.

He holds an M.A. in World Music from Antioch University and has studied with the master musicians of many world music traditions, including sarangi master Ram Narayan, sarod master Ali Akbar Khan, mridangam master Guruvayoor Dorai, vina master K.S. Subramanian, and gamelan directors Made Gerindem, Wayan Suweca, Pak Sinti and K.R.T. Wasitodipuro. He is the author of Ancient Traditions--Future Possibilities: Rhythmic Training Through the Traditions of Africa.


